I Membership and Subscription

- 1. There shall be no subscription for Ordinary Members in statu pupillari; otherwise, the subscription for Ordinary Members shall be a payment of $\pounds 2$ to be made annually.
- 2. All current students of mathematics or computer science at Clare Hall shall automatically receive Ordinary Membership.
- 3. The subscription for Associate Members shall be a payment of £2 to be made annually.
- 4. An Ordinary Member who has maintained their membership for 3 or more years after ceasing to be in statu pupillari shall automatically receive Honorary Membership.

II Committee Duties

- 1. The President shall be responsible for the running of the Association, and in particular for the arrangement of meetings.
- 2. The Treasurer shall be responsible for the running of the Association's finance, and in particular for the allocation of the annual budget.
- 3. The Secretary shall be responsible for the records and archives of the Association, and in particular for keeping the Membership Book and the minutes of meetings.
- 4. The Events Officer, if elected, shall be responsible for organising various events for the Members of the Association.
- 5. The Public Relations Officer, if elected, shall be responsible for the public relations issues of the Association, and in particular for its social media presence.

III Miscellaneous

- 1. The Association is currently not involved in any reciprocal arrangements with other College Societies.
- 2. The archives of the Society shall be deposited in the same place as the archives of Clare Hall.
